<u>Freshman Direct Admits</u>: All students accepted directly as freshmen into the Smith School must complete a series of gateway courses and submit to a review at 45 credits to determine continuing eligibility. Gateway courses include:

- Completion of BMGT 220, 221 and 230 with a minimum grade of C-
- Completion of MATH 220, 130 or 140 with a minimum grade of C-
- Completion of ECON 200 and 201 with a minimum grade of C-
- Completion of Fundamental Studies English

Students must be in the process of completing BMGT 221 and Econ 200 or 201 in the semester in which they reach 60 credits. Students should have completed 50% of their general education courses by the time they have reached 60 credits.

A minimum grade point average of 2.0 in all courses is required at the 45-credit review

<u>Transfer Admission Requirements:</u> Internal and external transfer students may apply to become business majors after they have earned 45 credits and, if **accepted provisionally**, will be accepted for the semester following the completion of 60 credits. Admission to the Smith School is highly competitive. Academic record, co-curricular involvement, leadership experience and honors and awards will be considered in the admission decision. Students are strongly encouraged to submit a resume and letter detailing their accomplishments and experience with their applications.

Students are accepted on a space-available basis after completing the following gateway courses:

- Completion of BMGT 220, 221 and 230 or 231 (or equivalent) with a minimum grade of C-
- Completion of ECON 200 and 201 with a minimum grade of C-
- Completion of MATH 220, 130 or 140 with a minimum grade of C- or above
- Completion of Fundamental Studies English

Students may be in the process of completing BMGT 221 and ECON 200 or 201 in the semester in which they apply for admission but must have completed all gateway courses by the end of the current semester. Students should have completed 50% of their general education courses by the time they have reached 60 credits. Applications are due on/before March 15th or June 15th for the Fall semester, and November 1 for the Spring semester. For fall admission, students will be notified in early April (and early December for spring admission) and will need to successfully complete the remainder of the gateway courses.

A minimum grade point average of 3.0 in all college coursework is required for consideration for all internal and external transfer applicants.

PLEASE NOTE

• Only one "gateway" or performance review course may be repeated to earn the required grade and that course may only be repeated once. This repeat must occur no later than the semester in which the student is applying for admission. **Students may**

not repeat a gateway course that was first taken in the semester in which they apply for admission to the Smith School.

- Students who are directly admitted and fail to meet the performance review criteria will be dismissed from the major and may not reapply.
- Application for BMGT at Shady Grove and College Park constitute separate program locations.
- Students must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00. Failure to do so will result in dismissal from the major.
- Any student denied admission or dismissed from the major may appeal to the Associate Dean of the College.
